Conditions of music tuition (Please keep for your own records)

1. Lessons

The Teacher will give tuition during school terms (term dates will be as specified by the school in accordance with Condition 3). The Teacher will give the lessons at the time and location specified overleaf and the Teacher will reserve this time slot for the Pupil.

2. Payment of fees

The Pupil (or the Pupil's parent or carer) will pay the fees for each term in full on or before the first lesson of the term. Weekly or monthly payments can be discussed and organised with the finance team on a case by case basis. Payments are to be made through the iPayimpact system that we use for trips and canteen accounts (this will begin from after February half term 2023).

3. Lesson timetable

Before the first lesson of each term, the Teacher will post the timetable, detailing the dates and times of all lessons during that term. This will be on the windows outside the Music Room. Copies of timetables are available on request.

4. Missed lessons

The school will charge for any scheduled lessons which the Pupil does not attend, unless the school chooses not to do so because of exceptional circumstances. If the Teacher or school cancels a scheduled lesson, the Pupil's parent or carer may choose between (i) receiving a replacement lesson, where possible; or (ii) receiving a refund of the lesson fee.

5. Examinations, competitions and public performances

The Pupil will not be entered for any examination, competition or public performance without the prior consent of both the school and the Pupil's parent or carer.

6. Termination of tuition

- (a) Lincolnshire Music Service sets out three termination dates each year by which notice of termination of this Agreement may be submitted. Notice of termination must be made to the school by each of these dates by the Pupil's parent or carer by signing and dating a written statement to that effect. Each termination deadline is for lessons to stop at the beginning of the following full term.
- (b) Where fees are not paid on time, the school reserves the right, entirely at the school's discretion, to terminate this Agreement at the next full term by giving written notice of termination to the Pupil's parent or carer. This right to terminate is without prejudice to any other rights the school may have. Payments up until the end of the term in which termination is made will still be liable.
- (c) Either signatory to this Agreement may terminate the Agreement by giving notice in writing to the other signatory before the Lincs Music Service termination dates for the termination to take effect at the end of that full term.
- (d) The Lincolnshire Music Service termination dates for 2023/24 are:
 - a. Friday 22nd September 2023 for termination from Tuesday 31st October 2023.
 - b. Friday 10th November 2023 for termination from Wednesday 3rd January 2024.
 - c. Friday 23rd February 2024 for termination from Tuesday 16th April 2024.
 - d. Friday 26th April 2024 for termination from Monday 3rd June (for year 11 only).
 - e. Friday 7th June 2024 for termination from the following September.

7. Failure to give notice

Unless terminated under Condition 6 above, this Agreement shall continue from full term to full term. If the Pupil's parent or carer fails to give full notice to terminate this Agreement in accordance with Condition 6(c) above and the signatories have not agreed to terminate the Agreement in accordance with Condition 6(a) above, the following charges will be made in lieu of notice:

(a) Where the notice given after the termination dates: 100% of the fees for the notice period.

If the Pupil stops attending lessons during the notice period, the Pupil's parent or carer is not entitled to a refund of any fees paid for that time period. The Pupil is entitled to attend any lessons paid for.

If the school stops lessons without giving the correct notice specified in Condition 6(c) above the school shall refund any fees already paid for any lessons not given.

8. Conduct

If the Teacher, in his or her reasonable opinion, feels unable to continue tuition on account of unreasonable conduct by the Pupil or anyone connected with the Pupil, the fees for any outstanding lessons will not be refundable.

9. Changes

- (a) Any changes to the terms of this Agreement must be confirmed in writing and signed and dated by both the Teacher and the Pupil (or the Pupil's parent or carer).
- (b) If the Teacher chooses to waive any right or remedy under this Agreement or otherwise (for example, if the Teacher chooses to waive fees for any lessons which the Pupil does not attend) this shall not mean that he or she must do so in future or that he or she waives any other rights or remedies, unless agreed in writing in accordance with Condition 9(a) above.

10. Communication between the parties

For the purposes of this Agreement written notice must be given on paper or by email.

11. Lincolnshire Music Service

All lessons are provided by Lincolnshire Music Service. In order for lessons to take place, you agree for your details to be shared with the Lincolnshire Music Service via their online portal, Speed Admin. LMS may contact you directly regarding teacher absences and exams.

12. Governing law and jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be subject to the laws of the jurisdiction of the location for the lessons (specified above) and the signatories to this Agreement agree that any dispute relating to the subject matter of this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that jurisdiction.
