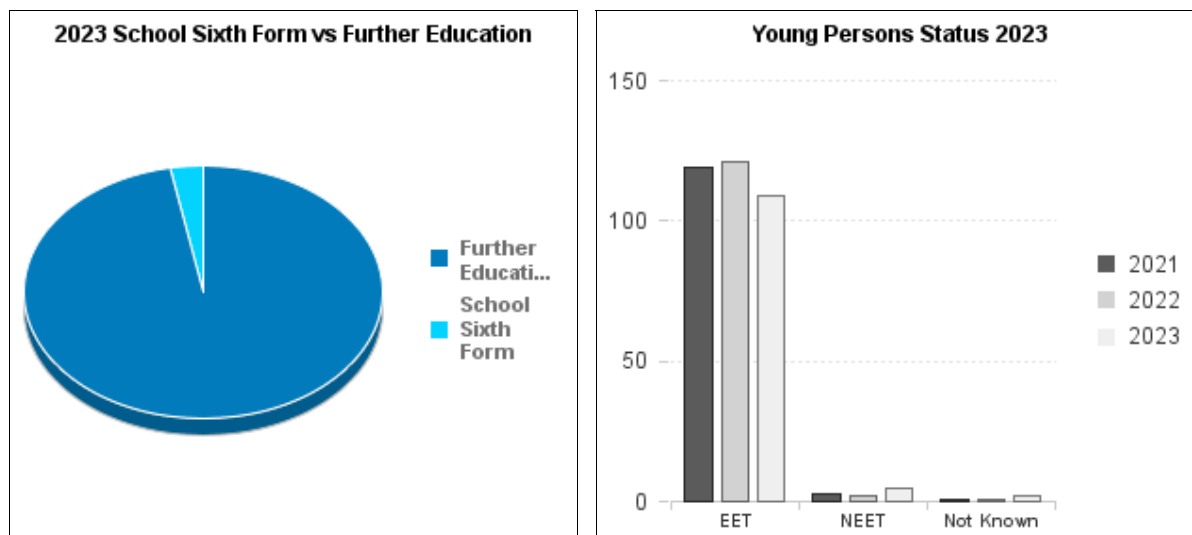

Not Known	A young person with a situation not currently known by the local authority.
